This complaint came up for final hearing before this Forum through video conferencing on 01.12.2023 in the presence of the complainant and respondents and having considered the complaint and submissions of both the parties, this Forum passed the following:

ORDER

01. The complainant submitted the complaint during the Vidyut Adalat conducted on 17.10.2023 at Piler stating that himself and another are having two (2) agricultural transformers (25 KVA) and they were stolen by unknown culprits on 22.09.2023, that they lodged a

complaint to the AE/O/Piler and the police concerned on which FIR in Crime No.244/2023 was registered but new transformers were not sanctioned by the department.

- Were issued to the respondents calling for their response. The respondents submitted their response stating that they have resolved the grievance of the complainant by erecting the two agricultural distribution transformers and thereby the grievance of the complainant was resolved.
- O3. Heard both the parties through video conferencing. The respondents submitted a letter reporting that they have erected two agricultural DTRs and resolved the grievance of the complainant. The complainant during the enquiry through video conferencing conducted on 01.12.2023 reported that their problem was solved by the respondents subsequent to the complaint and he confirmed the erection of the two agricultural Distribution Transformers. Since the grievance of the complainant was redressed, this Forum feel that this complaint can be closed.
- 04. In the result, the complaint is closed. There is no order as to costs.



05. The complainant is informed that if he is aggrieved by the order of the Forum, he may approach the Hon'ble Vidyut Ombudsman, 3rd Floor, Plot.
